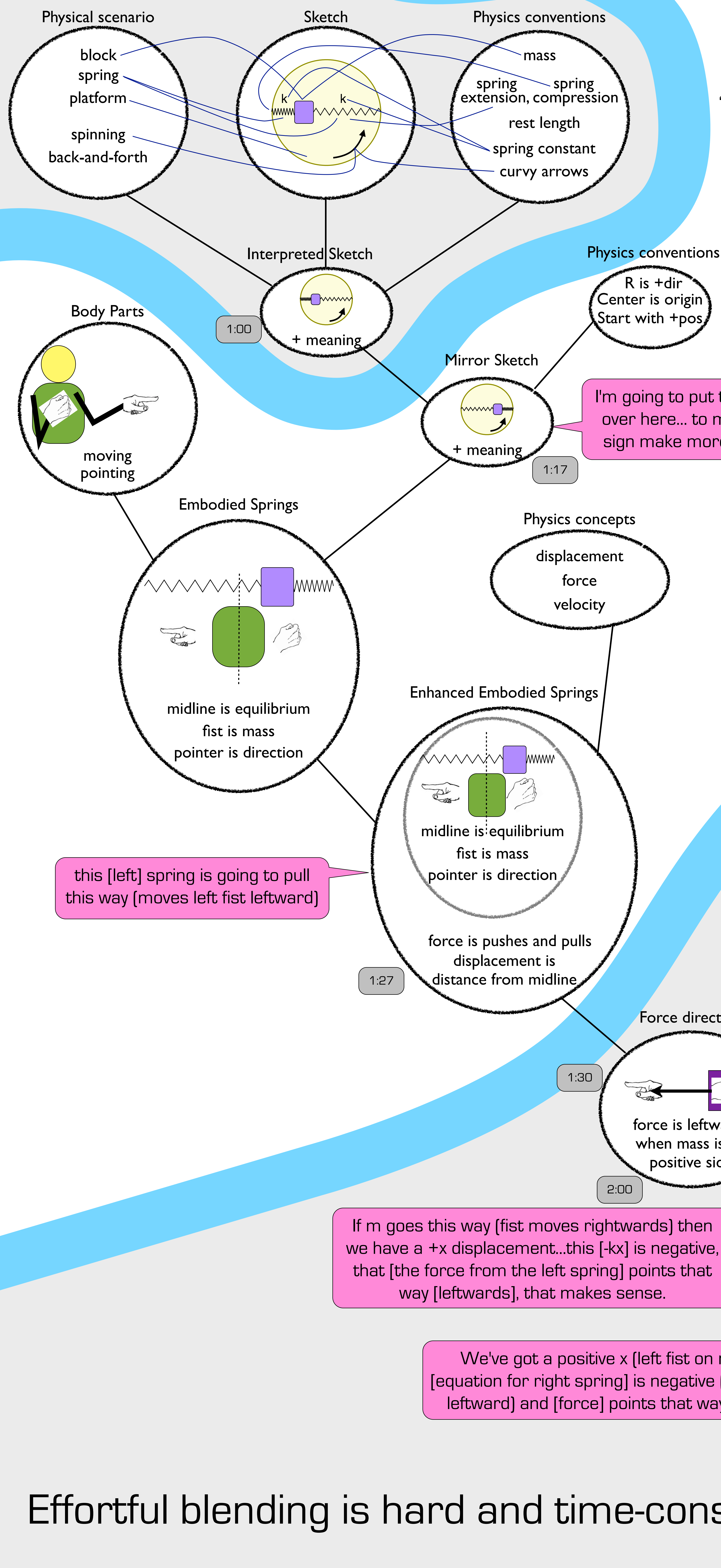


Effortful and Effortless Conceptual Blending

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"If you have a platform which rotates, and on the platform is a mass on a spring...The mass is constrained in the frame of the platform so that it can only go back and forth... Does the mass undergo simple harmonic motion?"
